

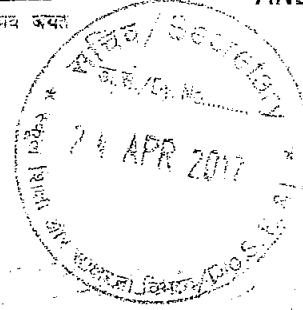

The present Government under the dynamic leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has taken several measures to provide improved and affordable health care to the citizens of India. The recent decision to regulate the prices of coronary stents too is a very important milestone in regulation of prices of drugs and medical devices, which is aimed to substantially reduce the burden on the pockets of the poor patients and their kin.

2. You may be aware that there is a very high incidence of Coronary Artery Disease (CAD) in India associated with high morbidity and mortality and coronary stent implantation is an important treatment. The Central Government has, therefore, included the same in the Schedule 1 of the Drugs (Prices Control) Order, 2013 on 21.12.2016, enabling National Pharmaceuticals Pricing Authority (NPPA) to regulate the prices of coronary stents and monitor their availability. NPPA, after detailed stakeholder consultations, notified the ceiling prices of the coronary stents on 13.02.2017 under two categories: -

3. The Government is taking all steps to ensure that the benefit is passed on to the intended beneficiaries mainly the economically backward patients requiring this treatment. Your valuable support in propagating this decision amongst the masses so that they could derive the benefits will be a highly appreciated contribution. I, personally, request you to educate the people of this decision of the Government and also help in monitoring the availability as well as the prices of stent will go a long way in ensuring that full benefits of the Government's measure are availed of by the poor patients.

4. Administratively, the Government has invoked the special powers of DPCO, 2013 to ensure the supply of coronary stents at these rates. Since, the individual patients or their kin may not be in a position to complain about overcharging by Hospitals/nursing homes, your intervention and support in monitoring the adequate availability of stents at the notified prices will be of good help to the poor patients in effectively implementation of the Government policy.

5. The National Pharma Pricing Authority (NPPA) and the Department of Pharma under my Ministry have been asked to co-ordinate with the elected representatives/ concerned authorities of the State Government and other stake holders to provide the required assistance, wherever, necessary. The NPPA had also requested the general public to make use of their website (www.nppa.gov.in) or on a helpline number 1800111255 to launch complaints relating to overcharging/ non-availability of stents. I would be happy to receive your valuable suggestions in this regard so that we can achieve the objectives of the decision of the Government in the interest of the people of our Country.

I would request your whole hearted support to this endeavour.
