

**Issue of medicines to CGHS beneficiaries at the time of
discharge from empanelled private hospitals**

With reference to the above-mentioned subject, the undersigned is directed to state that this Ministry has been receiving representations regarding difficulties being faced by CGHS beneficiaries in getting medicines immediately after discharge from empanelled private hospitals.

2. The matter has been examined in the Ministry and with a view to alleviate the inconvenience to CGHS beneficiaries in getting medicines immediately after discharge from empanelled private hospitals, it has been decided that CGHS beneficiaries who had taken in-patient medical treatment from a CGHS empanelled private hospital will be issued medicines from the treating private hospital at the time of discharge, for a period up to seven (7) days. The hospital will raise bill for the medicines separately and submit it along with the hospital bill for inpatient treatment, to CGHS for reimbursement in case of pensioner beneficiaries who are entitled to avail cashless medical treatment at the hospital.

3. In case of serving CGHS beneficiaries, if the treatment is provided by the hospital on credit basis (in deserving cases), they may raise bills for medicines supplied to the patient for post hospitalization period (up to 7 days after discharge), and claim reimbursement from the department / office concerned along with the hospital bill for in-patient treatment. In other cases, where the in-patient treatment is provided to serving CGHS beneficiaries on payment basis, the empanelled private hospital will supply medicines for up to 7 days period on payment basis, for which employee can claim reimbursement from his/her office. However, it will be up to the serving CGHS beneficiary to purchase the prescribed medicines from the hospital at the time of discharge (for up to 7 days) or get it from a CGHS dispensary, as may be convenient to him.

4. The above facility will however, be subject to the following conditions:—

- (i) Only essential medicines in generic form for continuity of treatment will be issued by the hospital.
- (ii) No Nutritional supplements, tonic, cough syrup, vitamins, injections will be issued by the hospital. These are not allowed.
- (iii) No non-drug items / equipments / appliances will be issued.
- (iv) Total cost of such medicines issued by the hospital must not exceed ₹ 2,000 in any case.

5. This Office Memorandum shall come into force from the date of issue.

Relaxation of procedures to be followed in considering requests for medical reimbursement claims in respect of CS (MA) beneficiaries

Ministry of Health and Family Welfare received several representations from CGHS beneficiaries for issue of guidelines to be followed in considering requests for relaxation of procedures in considering requests for medical reimbursement over and above the approved rates. The matter was examined by the Ministry and Office Memorandum No.4-18/2005-C&P(Vol-1 Pt(i)), dated the 20th February,2009, was issued prescribing the procedures and guidelines to be followed for consideration of requests received from CGHS beneficiaries seeking reimbursement of expenditure incurred on medical treatment over and above the approved rates. The requirement of essentiality certificate in respect of CGHS beneficiaries was also done away with.

However, no such guidelines were issued under CS (MA) Rules. In this regard Department-related Parliamentary Standing Committee on Health and Family Welfare in the seventy-first report impressed upon the Department to immediately address this issue and extend same facilities to those covered under CS (MA) Rules and to issue a fresh circular clarifying the procedures in this regard and dispelling misgivings, if any. Ministry was also in receipt of representation from several quarters in this regard.

2. The matter has been examined in consultation with Dte. GHS and it has been decided to revise the guidelines for reimbursement by the Competent Authority to issue guidelines under CS (MA) on similar pattern as under CGHS as per the following:—

- (1) It has now been decided to do away with the procedure for verification of bills and issue of essentiality certificate by the treating doctor and the Medical Superintendent of the hospital. Ministries / Authorities concerned may verify and check the authenticity of the claims on the basis of the prescription slip and the diagnostic report submitted by the Government servant. In the event of any doubt, the concerned Ministry / Authority can always get verification done from the hospital concerned.
- (2) It is clarified that essentiality certificate / counter-signature of treating doctor in a hospital would not, henceforth, be necessary. However, essentiality certificate would be required when the treatment is taken from an AMA on OPD basis.
- (3) All cases involving requests for relaxation of rules for reimbursement of full expenditure will henceforth be referred

to the Technical Standing Committee, to be chaired by the DGHS/Spl.DGHS and Specialists of concerned subject as members, Addl. DDG (MG-Section) Dte GHS shall be member secretary for organizing the meetings of Technical Standing Committee. If Technical Standing Committee recommends the relaxation of rules for permitting full reimbursement of expenditure incurred by the beneficiary, the full reimbursement may be allowed by the Secretary (Health and Family Welfare) in consultation with IFD. A check-list for consideration of requests for reimbursement in excess of the approved rates may include:

- (a) The treatment was obtained in a private hospital not empanelled under CS (MA) / CGHS under emergency and the patient was admitted by others when the beneficiary was unconscious or severely incapacitated and was hospitalized for a prolonged period;
- (b) The treatment was obtained in a private hospital not empanelled under CS (MA) / CGHS under emergency and was admitted for prolonged period for treatment of Head injury, Coma, Septicemia, Multi-organ failure, etc.;
- (c) Treatment was obtained in a private hospital not empanelled under CS (MA) / CGHS under emergency for treatment of advanced malignancy;
- (d) Treatment was taken in a private hospital not empanelled under CS (MA) / CGHS under emergency in higher type of accommodation as rooms as per his/her entitlement was not available during that period;
- (e) Treatment was taken in higher type of accommodation under specific conditions for isolation of patients to avoid contacting infections;
- (f) Treatment was obtained in private hospital not empanelled under CS (MA) / CGHS under emergency while on official tour to another city;
- (g) Treatment was obtained in a private hospital not empanelled under CS (MA) / CGHS under emergency when there is a strike in Government hospitals;
- (h) Approval for air-fare with or without attendant on the advice of treating doctor for treatment in another city even though he is not eligible for air travel / treatment facilities are available in city of residence and
- (i) Any other special circumstances.

**CS (MA) Rules 1944 — Renewal of name of the AMA for the
treatment of Central Government Employees' and Members of
their family for the period from 1-8-2014 to 31-7-2015**

In terms of Ministry of Health and Family Planning's (Department of Health) instructions contained in O.M. No. 9-14025/133/79-MS, dated 28-5-1982 and C & A. G. Circular No. 445-Audit/17/87/III-90 (86), dated 10-8-1990 and as per Rule 2A (iv) of the CS (MA) Rules 1944, the name of the Private Medical Practitioners, as mentioned in Annexure-AMA-1, are hereby renewed as Authorized Medical Attendant during the normal working hours for the treatment of the Central Government Employees' and members of their family stationed at, or passing through, Kolkata and its adjoining Municipalities (as shown against each AMA) which are not covered by CGHS for a period of one year, i.e., from 1-8-2014 to 31-7-2015.

Annexure-I contains the names of the Authorized Medical Attendants who were empanelled during the year 2013-14, but have not submitted application for renewal as AMA for the year 2014-15, and have expressed their unwillingness to continue. Accordingly, their names are hereby removed from the list of Authorized Medical Attendants for the year 2014-15.

**(IMPORTANT NOTE FOR THE AMAs
TO BE OBSERVED STRICTLY)**

1. AMAs are requested to submit applications for renewal at least 3 months before the date of expiry of the present term. The CGEWCC reserves the right to delete any name due to non-receipt of application for renewal in time.
2. AMAs are requested not to prescribe medicines for more than 3 to 4 days at a time. However, in case of 3 or 4 consultations, the treatment should be restricted to maximum period of ten days. The fees for consultation and injection should be taken as per G.I. M.H., O.M.No.S-14025/10/2010-MS dated 17-3-2011 of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (Department of Health) New Delhi.
3. Any change in address/degree, etc. should be intimated immediately with documentary evidence. In case of death of AMA, intimation has to be sent to the Secretary, CGEWCC, Kolkata by the nearest relative of the AMA with a copy of death certificate.

CS (MA) Rules, 1944 — Renewal of name of the AMA for the treatment of Central Government Employees' and Members of their family for the period from 1-8-2014 to 31-7-2015

In terms of Ministry of Health and Family Planning's (Department of Health) instructions contained in O.M. No. 9-14025/133/79-MS, dated 28-5-1982 and C & A.G. Circular No. 445-Audit/1787/III-90 (86), dated 10-8-1990 and as per Rule 2A (iv) of the CS (MA) Rules 1944, the names of the Private Medical Practitioners, as mentioned in Annexure-AMA-2, are hereby renewed as Authorized Medical Attendant during the normal working hours for the treatment of the Central Government Employees' and members of their family residing at the station mentioned against each AMA, and places within a radius of 16 km thereof, which are falling outside the definition of city limit of Kolkata and not covered by CGHS, for a period of one year, i.e., from 1-8-2014 to 31-7-2015.

**(IMPORTANT NOTE FOR THE AMAS
TO BE OBSERVED STRICTLY)**

1. AMAs are requested to submit applications for renewal at least 3 months before the date of expiry of present term. The CGEWCC reserves the right to delete any name due to non-receipt of application for renewal in time.

2. AMAs are requested not to prescribe medicines for more than 3 to 4 days at a time. However, in case of 3 or 4 consultations, the treatment should be restricted to maximum period of ten days. The fees for consultation and injection should be taken as per G.I. M.H., O.M.No.S-14025/10/2010-MS dated 17-3-2011 of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (Department of Health) New Delhi.

3. Any change in address / degree, etc. should be intimated immediately with documentary evidence. In case of death of AMA, an intimation has to be sent to the Secretary, CGEWCC, Kolkata by the nearest relative of the AMA with a copy of death certificate.

With reference to the above-mentioned subject, the undersigned is directed to draw attention to the Office Memoranda No.S.11011/7/95-CGHS(P), dated 12-6-1996 and 26-164/98-R&H/CGHS/CGHS(P), dated 22-11-1999 vide which ceiling rates and guidelines were prescribed for various types of Pacemakers, Rotablator and AICD and to state that while the ceiling rates for coronary stents have been revised from time to time separately the rates and guidelines for pacemakers, Rotablator and AICD and to state that while the ceiling rates for coronary stents have been revised from time to time separately the rates and guidelines for pacemakers, Rotablator and AICD were not revised. 2. Permission for the above-mentioned implants shall be granted on the basis of advice of Government cardiologist by CMO in-charge / Additional Director / Joint Director, CGHS in case of pensioners, former Governors, former Vice-Presidents, ex-MPs, Freedom Fighters, etc., by Rajya Sabha / Lok Sabha Secretariat, as the case may be in case of sitting Members of Parliament and by the concerned Ministry / Department / Organization in case of serving Government employees, serving employees and pensioners of autonomous bodies covered under CGHS. The reimbursement shall be limited to the ceiling rate or actual rate, whichever may be less.

3. The Warranty terms and conditions as specified by the manufacturer shall be applicable in case of replacement of a device.

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4. In case of requests for replacement of a device, a copy of the tails of the earlier device as well as a copy of terms and conditions of warranty shall be enclosed along with the advice of Government specialist.

5. A copy of the device 'ID No. Sticker' and a copy of terms of warranty shall be enclosed along with the bill of device for reimbursement.

6. In case of implantation of any of the devices in emergency, reimbursement shall be subject to *ex post facto* approval by Addl. Director / Joint Director, CGHS of city, in consultation with experts, if necessary.

7. These orders are in supersession of earlier guidelines and ceiling rates issued in this regard.

8. The rates shall be valid for a period of two years or till further revision, whichever may be earlier.

9. This issues with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division CD No. C 756, dated 14-7-2014.

**Suspension of empanelment of Shanti Gopal Hospital,
Indira Puram, Ghaziabad**

With reference to the above-mentioned matter, the undersigned is directed to draw attention to the Office Memorandum No. S-11011/23/2009-CGHS-D-II/Hospital Cell (pt.), dated 7-10-2010 *vide* which Shanti Gopal Hospital, Indira Puram, Ghaziabad was empanelled under CGHS and to state that Shanti Gopal Hospital, Indira Puram, Ghaziabad has violated the terms and conditions of MoA signed the CGHS and has refused credit facilities to bona fide CGHS beneficiaries. A show-cause notice was issued to the hospital and reply received was found to be unsatisfactory. In view of this, it has been decided to suspend empanelment of Shanti Gopal Hospital, Indira Puram, Ghaziabad from CGHS with immediate effect till further orders.

The CGHS beneficiaries already admitted in the hospital for treatment prior to the issue of this order shall however be continued to provide treatment at CGHS rates.

Withdrawal from the list of Diagnostic Laboratories and Imaging Centers empanelled under CGHS, Delhi — as per recommendations of the Ethics Committee of Medical Council of India

With reference to the above-mentioned subject, it is stated that subsequent to the sting operation titled "Operation Jonk" aired by a TV Channel, the Ethics Committee of Medical Council of India conducted an enquiry into the matter as per the directions of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. In the interim report submitted by MCI, nine Diagnostic Centres have been prima facie found involved in unethical medical practices. In view of the recommendation of the Ethics Committee of MCI, it has been decided that pending investigation, the empanelment of these centres with CGHS be withdrawn.

Amendment to CCS (Commutation of Pension) Rules, 1981

G.S.R. 355 (E).— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 and Clause (5) of Article 148 of the Constitution and after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India in relation to persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Central Civil Services (Commutation of Pension) Rules, 1981, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Central Civil Services (Commutation of Pension) Second Amendment Rules, 2014.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Central Civil Services (Commutation of Pension) Rules, 1981, —

(a) in Rule 5, in sub-rule (2), for the words and figures “in Form 1 or Form 1-A or Form 2”, the words and figures “in Form 5 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972 or in Form 1 or Form 1-A or Form 2 of these rules” shall be *substituted*;

(b) in Rule 12, in the proviso, for the words, figures and letter “in Form 1 or Form 1-A”, the words, figures, brackets and letter “in Form 5 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972 or in Form 1 or Form 1-A of these rules” shall be *substituted*;

(c) in Rule 13,—

(i) for sub-rule (3), the following sub-rules shall be *substituted*, namely:—

“(3) A Government servant who is due to retire on superannuation and desires payment of the commuted value of pension being authorized at the time of issue of the pension payment order, shall be eligible to apply in Form 5 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972 for commutation of a percentage of pension along with pension papers prior to the date of retirement.

(3-A) If a Government servant referred to in sub-rule (3) desires to apply for commutation of a percentage of pension after submission of pension papers and Form 5 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972, he shall apply for the same in Form 1-A.

(3-B) The application for commutation of a percentage of pension under sub-rule (3) or sub-rule (3-A) shall be subject to the following; namely:—

(a) the Government servant retires on superannuation pension only;

(b) the application is submitted to the Head of Office in Form 1-A of these rules or in Form 5 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972, so as to reach the Head of Office not later than three months before the date of superannuation;

- (c) no such application shall be entertained if the period is less than three months from the date of superannuation of the Government servant; and
- (d) the Government shall have no liability for the payment of the commuted value of pension if the Government servant dies before the date of superannuation or forfeits claim to pension before such retirement."
- (d) in Rule 15, in sub-rule (3),—
- (i) in Clause (a), for the word, figure and letter "Form 1-A", the words, figures, brackets and letter "in Form 5 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972 or Form 1-A of these rules" shall be *substituted*;
- (ii) in Clause (b), in sub-clause (i), for the word, figure and letter "Form 1-A", the words, figures, brackets and letter "in Form 5 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972 or Form 1-A of these rules" shall be *substituted*;
- (e) for Form 1, Form 1-A and Form 2, the following shall respectively be *substituted*, namely:—

Requirement of Life Certificate at the time of first credit of pension

It has been observed that banks insist on the pensioners to physically appear in the bank to prove their existence to enable the bank authorities to issue Life Certificate before commencing first payment of pension. In this context, as per existing arrangement, no provision of submission of life certificate at the time of first credit of pension is available. Moreover, as conveyed by this Office O.M. No. CPAO/Tech./Simplification/2014-15/ dated 28-5-2014 (*copy enclosed — not printed*), physical appearance at the paying branch is no longer required even for identification of pensioner. The bank has to identify the pensioner with reference to the information already available with bank obtained through KYC at the time of opening of bank account.

Therefore, Heads of Government Business Department of all banks are advised to instruct their CPPC and paying branches not to insist on pensioners to issue life certificate at the time of first credit of pension.

**Simplification of pension procedure — submission of undertaking
by retiring Government servant along with pension papers**

“The Scheme for Payment of pensions to Central Government C. Pensioners through Authorized Banks” issued by CPAO provides for undertaking of recovery of overpayment to be submitted by the retiring Government servant / pensioner to the pension disbursing bank before commencement of pension. Delayed submission of this undertaking has been a main reason in crediting the first payment of pension to pensioners account.

In order to simplify the pension procedure and consequent upon delinking of commencement of pension with the first time identification of the pensioner by bank, the Department of Pension and Pensioners' Welfare has approved the submission of undertaking by the retiring Government servant along with pension papers before his retirement.

Now, the required undertaking may be obtained by the Head of Office from the retiring Government servant along with Form 5 and other documents before his retirement and forwarded the same to Pay and Accounts Office along with pension case for onward transmission to bank through CPAO. The undertaking shall be addressed to the Branch Manager of the Pension Account Holding Branch and in the prescribed format (*copy enclosed*).

These instructions were earlier issued by Department of Pension and Pensioners' Welfare vide their OM, dated the 7th May, 2014 and CPAO vide its OM, dated the 28th May, 2014 (available on CPAOs' website). But it has been noticed that Head of the Offices and Pay and Accounts Offices are not even aware of these instructions so far. Consequently, these instructions are not being implemented and the main reason of delay in first credit of pension by the banks still persists. This is a matter of great concern.

Therefore, all Pr. CCAs/CCAs/CAs are requested to issue directions to their PAOs for complying with the OM No. CPAO/Tech/Simplification/2014-15/52, dated 28-5-2014 and to ensure that all pension cases received from Head of Offices are supported with undertaking of recovery of overpayment and the same is invariably forwarded to CPAO as a part of PPO booklet for onward transmission to CPPC of the bank. All authorization sections in CPAO have already been directed not to accept any pension case for authorization of pension payment received without the undertaking.

**Consolidated Instructions on Probation / Confirmation
in Central Services**

The undersigned is directed to say that this Department has been issuing instructions / guidelines from time to time laying down principles to be followed in probation / confirmation of persons appointed to services and posts in Central Government. All such instructions issued till date have been consolidated under easily comprehensible headings for the facility of reference and placed as Annexure to this O.M. The number and date of the original OMs has been referred in the relevant instructions for easy reference in the context. All Ministries / Departments are requested to bring the above guidelines to the notice of all concerned.

2. There may be posts in various Ministries / Departments / Organizations where the norms specified in the Recruitment Rules are different from those prescribed in the Annexure. In such cases, the norms specified in those Recruitment Rules shall prevail.

Annexure

PROBATION AND CONFIRMATION

A person is appointed on probation in order to assess his suitability for absorption in the service to which he has been appointed. Probation should not, therefore be treated as a mere formality. No formal declaration shall be necessary in respect of appointment on probation. The appointing authority may declare successful completion, extend the period of probation or terminate the services of a temporary employee on probation, on the basis of evaluation of performance.

2. Probation is prescribed when there is direct recruitment, promotion from one Group to another or for officers re-employed before the age of superannuation. The probation shall stand successfully completed on issue of orders in writing. It is, however, not desirable that a Government servant should be kept on probation for long periods.

PERIOD OF PROBATION

3. The period of probation is prescribed for different posts / services in Central Government on the following lines:

1.	Promotion from one grade to another but within the same group of posts e.g. from Group 'C' to Group 'C'	No probation.

(A) DIRECT RECRUITMENT

(40)

If a Government servant is appointed to another post by direct recruitment either in the same department or a different department, it may be necessary to consider him for confirmation in the new post in which he has been appointed by direct recruitment irrespective of the fact that the officer was holding the earlier post on a substantive basis. Further confirmation in the new entry grade becomes necessary because the new post may not be in the same line or discipline as the old post in which he has been confirmed and the fact that he was considered suitable for continuance in the old post (which was the basis for his confirmation in that post) would not automatically make him suitable for continuance or confirmation in the new post, the job requirements of which may be quite different from those of the old post.

(B) PROMOTION

(i) Persons who are inducted into a new service through promotion shall also be placed on probation but there shall be no probation on promotion from one grade to another but within the same group of posts, except when the promotion involves a change in the Group of posts in the same service, e.g., promotion from Group 'B' to Group 'A' in which case the probation would be for the prescribed period.

(ii) If the Recruitment Rules do not prescribe any probation, an officer appointed on regular basis (after following the prescribed DPC procedure, etc.) will have all the benefits that a person confirmed in that grade would have.

(iii) There shall be no probation in the cases for appointment on contract basis, tenure basis, re-employment after superannuation and absorption.

PROGRESS DURING PROBATION

4. Instead of treating probation as a formality, the existing powers to discharge probationers should be systematically and vigorously used so that the necessity of dispensing with the services of employees at later stages may arise only rarely.

5. Concentration of attention on the probationer's ability to pass the probationary or the departmental examination, if applicable, should be an essential part of the qualification for confirmation but there should be a very careful assessment of the outlook, character and aptitude for the kind of work that has to be done in the service before a probationer is confirmed.

6. A probationer should be given an opportunity to work under more than one officer during this period and reports of his work obtained

from each one of those officers. The probation reports for the whole period may then be considered by a Board of senior officials for determining whether the probationer concerned is fit to be confirmed in service. For this purpose, separate forms of report on the probationers should be used, which are distinct from the usual Annual Performance Appraisal Report (APAR) forms. The probation reports, unlike APAR, are written to help the supervising officer to concentrate on the special needs of probation and to decide whether the work and conduct of the officer during the period of probation or the extended period of probation are satisfactory enough to warrant his further retention in service or post. The probation reports thus do not serve the purpose for which the APARs are written and vice versa. Therefore, in the case of all probationers or officers on probation, separate probation reports should be written in addition to the usual APARs for the period of probation.

7. Save for exceptional reasons, probation should not be extended for more than a year and in no circumstance an employee should be kept on probation for more than double the normal period.

8. A probationer, who is not making satisfactory progress, should be informed of his shortcomings well before the expiry of the original probationary period so that he can make special efforts at self-improvement. This can be done by giving him a written warning to the effect that his general performance has not been such as to justify his confirmation and that, unless he showed substantial improvement within a specified period, the question of discharging him would have to be considered. Even though this is not required by the rules, discharge from the service being a severe, final and irrevocable step, the probationer should be given an opportunity before taking the drastic step of discharge.

9. During the period of probation, or any extension thereof, candidates may be required by Government to undergo such courses of training and instructions and to pass examinations, and tests (including examination in Hindi) as Government may deem fit, as a condition to satisfactory completion of the probation.

TERMINATION OF PROBATION

10. The decision whether an employee should be confirmed or his probation extended should be taken soon after the expiry of the initial probationary period, that is within six to eight weeks, and communicated to the employee together with the reasons in case of extension. A probationer who is not making satisfactory progress or who shows himself to be inadequate for the service in any way should be informed of his shortcomings well before the expiry of the original probationary period so that he can make special efforts at self-improvement.

42 11. On the expiry of the period of probation, steps should be taken to obtain the assessment reports on the probationer to:—

- (i) Confirm the probationer / issue orders regarding satisfactory termination of probation, as the case may be, if the probation has been completed to the satisfaction of the competent authority; or
- (ii) Extend the period of probation or discharge the probationer or terminate the services of the probationer as the case may be, in accordance with the relevant rules and orders if the probationer has not completed the period of probation satisfactorily.

12. In order to ensure that delays do not occur in confirmation, timely action must be initiated in advance so that the time-limit is adhered to.

13. If it appears to the Appointing Authority, at any time, during or at the end of the period that a Government servant has not made sufficient use of his opportunities or is not making satisfactory progress, the Appointing Authority may revert him to the post held substantively by him immediately preceding his appointment, provided he holds a lien thereon or in other cases may discharge or terminate him from service.

14. A Probationer reverted or discharged from service during or at the end of the period of probation shall not be entitled to any compensation.

EXTENSION OF PROBATION PERIOD

15. If during the period of probation, a probationer has not undergone the requisite training course or passed the requisite departmental examinations prescribed (proficiency in Hindi, etc.), if any, the period or periods as may be necessary, subject to the condition that the total period of probation does not exceed double the prescribed period of probation.

16. The Appointing Authority may, if it so thinks fit, extend the period of probation of a Government servant by a specified period but the total period of probation does not exceed double the normal period. In such cases, periodic reviews should be done and extension should not be done for a long period at one time.

17. Where a probationer who has completed the period of probation to the satisfaction of the Central Government is required to be confirmed, he shall be confirmed in the Service / Post at the end of his period of probation, having been completed satisfactorily.

LEAVE TO PROBATIONER, A PERSON ON PROBATION

43

18. A person appointed to a post on probation shall be entitled to leave under the rules as a temporary or a permanent Government servant according as his appointment is against a temporary or a permanent post. Where such person already holds a lien on a permanent post before such appointment, he shall be entitled to leave as a permanent Government servant.

19. The period of joining time availed of by a probationer on return from leave should be counted towards the prescribed period of probation if but for the leave, he would have continued to officiate in the post to which he was appointed.

20. If, for any reason, it is proposed to terminate the services of a probationer, any leave which may be granted to him shall not extend—

- (i) beyond the date on which the probation period as already sanctioned or extended expires, or
- (ii) beyond any earlier date on which his services are terminated by the orders of an authority competent to appoint him.

[Rule 33, CCS (Leave) Rules, 1972]

CONFIRMATION

21. If, during the period of probation or any extension thereof, as the case may be, Government is of the opinion that an officer is not fit for permanent appointment, Government may discharge or revert the officer to the post held by him prior to his appointment in the service, as the case may be.

22. Confirmation will be made only once in the service of an official which will be in the entry grade post / service / cadre, provided further confirmation shall be necessary when there is fresh entry subsequently in any other post / service / cadre by way of direct recruitment or otherwise. Confirmation is de-linked from the availability of permanent vacancy in the grade. In other words, an officer who has successfully completed the probation, as prescribed under relevant rules, may be considered for confirmation. A specific order of confirmation will be issued when the case is cleared, from all angles.

23. On satisfactory completion of the period of probation or extension thereof, the Government may confirm a temporary Government servant to his appointment from the date of completion of the period of his probation or extension thereof.

24. The date from which confirmation should be given effect to is the date following the date of satisfactory completion of the prescribed period of probation or the extended period of probation, as the case may be. The decision to confirm the probationer or to extend the period of probation, as the case may be should be communicated to the probationer normally within 6 to 8 weeks. Confirmation of the probationer after completion of the period of probation is not automatic but is to be followed by formal orders. As long as no specific orders of confirmatory satisfactory completion of probation are issued to a probationer, such a probationer shall be deemed to have continued on probation.

25. Where probation on promotion is prescribed, the appointing authority will on completion of the prescribed period of probation assess the work and conduct of the officer himself and in case the conclusion is that the officer is fit to hold the higher grade he will pass an order declaring that the person concerned has successfully completed the probation. If the appointing authority considers that the work of the officer has not been satisfactory or needs to be watched for some more time, he may revert him to the post / service / cadre from which he was promoted, or extend the period of probation, as the case may be.

26. Since there will be no confirmation on promotion before an official is declared to have completed the probation satisfactory, a rigorous screening of his performance should be made and there should be no hesitation to revert a person to the post or grade from which he was promoted if the work of the officer during probation has not been satisfactory.

27. A Government servant appointed by transfer would duly have been confirmed in the earlier post. In such a case, further confirmation in the new post would not be necessary and he could be treated as permanent in the new post. Where, however, a Government servant who has not already been confirmed in the old post is appointed by transfer, it would be necessary to confirm him in the new post. In such cases, he may be considered for confirmation after watching him for two years. Within that period of two years, the officer would earn two reports in the new grade and the DPC may consider his case for confirmation on the basis of these APARs.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Fixation of pay of State Government Employees on their appointment in Central Government, subsequent to implementation of CCS (RP) Rules, 2008.

The undersigned is directed to say that the method of fixation of pay of State Government employees on their appointment under the Central Government has been spelt out in this Department's OM No. 12/1/94-Estt(Pay-I) dated 24 March, 1994, 3rd January, 1996 and OM NO. 13/2/99-Estt (Pay-I) dated 18.6.2001.

2. The question of fixation of pay in cases of appointment from State Govt. to Central Govt. consequent upon revision of pay scales on acceptance of the recommendations of the VI Central Pay Commission in the revised pay structure has been considered in consultation with the Department of Expenditure and the President is pleased to decide that in cases of appointment of State Government employees in Central Government on or after 1.1.2006, pay will be fixed in the following manner:-

- (a) Where the State Government has revised the Pay scales of their employees on the pattern of VI Central Pay Commission at the **base index of 115.76 as per AICPI (IW) 2001 series** w.e.f. 1.1.2006 the pay of these State Government employees on their appointment under the Central Government would be fixed as follows:
- (i) When the appointment is to a post carrying higher Grade Pay, one increment equal to 3% of the sum of the pay in the existing grade pay will be computed and rounded off to the next multiple of 10. This will then be added to the existing pay in the pay band. The grade pay corresponding to the higher post will thereafter be granted in addition to this pay in the pay band. In cases where the appointment involves change in pay band also, the same methodology will be followed. However, if the pay in the pay band after adding the increment is less than the minimum of the higher pay band to which the appointment is taking place, pay in the pay band will be stepped up to such minimum.
 - (ii) Where the appointment is to a post involving identical Grade Pay, the individual shall continue to draw the same pay.
- (b) Where the State Government have revised the pay scales of their employees after 1.1.2006 **beyond the base index of 115.76 as per AICPI (IW) 2001 series**, basic pay of the employees is to be determined first in the Central Scale by reducing the element of DA, ADA, IR etc. granted by the State Government after 1.1.2006

..... 2/-

(beyond the base index of 115.76 as per AICPI (IW) 2001 series) and thereafter the pay would be fixed as provided in the clause (i) &(ii) under sub-para (a) above.

(c) Where the state Government have either not revised or revised the pay scale of their employees on or after 1.1.2006 below the base index of 115.76 as per AICPI (IW) 2001 series, basic pay of these employees shall be determined first in the Central scale, by adding the element of D.A. ADA upto base index of 115.76 as per AICPI (IW) 2001 series granted by the State Government and thereafter their pay would be fixed as provided in the clause (i) &(ii) under sub-para (a) above.

3. These orders are applicable to employees of the State Government and local bodies under the State including Emergency Divisional Accountants/Divisional Accountants/ local bodies under the State Government appointed under Central Government on or after 1.1.2006.

4. In so far as the employees serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders issue after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.



OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject - **'Facilitation Fee' levied by authorised travel agents on air tickets booked on Government account - Withdrawal regarding.**

Attention is invited to this Department's O.M. of even number dated 10th October, 2013 wherein the authorised travel agents namely M/s Balmer Lawrie & Company Limited (BLCL), M/s Ashok Travels & Tours (ATT) and Indian Railways Catering and Tourism Corporation Ltd. (IRCTC), were allowed to levy 'Facilitation Fee' @ ₹100/- per ticket for domestic sector and ₹300/- per ticket for international sector for air travel, wherein Government of India bears the cost of air passage.

2. The issue has been re-examined in consultation with the Ministry of Civil Aviation and Department of Legal Affairs, in the light of provisions of the Aircrafts Rules, 1937, as amended from time to time, and it has been decided to withdraw this Department's O.M. of even number dated 10th October, 2013 with immediate effect. Consequently, no fee/service charges (by whatever nomenclature), which are not included in the tariff charged by Air India/Airlines, are required to be paid to the authorised travel agents.

3. Payment to the authorised travel agents for the Bills raised by them for air tickets procured/purchased till date, in respect of air travel already undertaken or due to be undertaken, would be regulated as per O.M. of even number dated 10.10.2013. It is reiterated that, as far as possible, air tickets on Government account may be obtained directly from Air India/Airlines (booking counters/offices/website) and if obtaining tickets directly from Air India/Airlines is not possible, should the services of authorised travel agents be availed of.

4. All Ministries/Departments are advised to bring these instructions to the notice of all concerned for compliance.
