United States -India Educational Foundation (USIEF) has announced the 2019-20 Fulbright Teaching Excellence and Achievement (FTEA) program for full time school teachers (grades 6 to 12) teaching English, English as foreign Language (EFL), Social Studies, Mathematics, Science and Special Education at schools in the states of **Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Jharkhand, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura, West Bengal, Chandigarh, Delhi, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh.** This competition is open only to teachers from the states mentioned above and not the rest of India. The U.S. Government sponsored program provides International teachers with unique opportunities to develop expertise in their subject areas, enhance their teaching skills and increase their knowledge about the United States.

The last date of submission of application on-line to the USIEF is 1st April, 2019.



United States-India Educational Foundation (USIEF) has also announced another program -- 2019-2020 Fulbright Teaching Excellence and Achievement (FTEA) Program for full-time school teachers (6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grades) teaching English, English as a Foreign Language (EFL), Social Studies, Mathematics, Science, or Special Education at schools in the states of **Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Jharkhand, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura, West Bengal, Chandigarh, Delhi, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh**. This program provides international teachers with a unique opportunity to develop greater expertise in their subject areas, enhance their teaching skills, and increase their knowledge about the United States.

The Fulbright TEA program is a six-week non-degree, non-credit academic program at a U.S. University. The international participants will travel to the United States for one of two six-week professional development programs in either spring of 2020 or fall of 2020. The program provides academic seminars on teaching methodologies and strategies, curriculum development, lesson planning, and instructional technology training. Intensive English language instruction will be offered to teachers who need additional practice. The program will also include a practicum of at least 40 hours with a U.S. partner teacher in a U.S. secondary school near the host university to actively engage participants in the U.S. classroom environment. Cultural enrichment, mentoring, and support will be provided to participants throughout the program. Selected Indian teachers will receive round-trip transportation, housing (generally shared with other program fellows) and meals, applicable allowances and will travel on J-1 visas.

**Application deadline for Indian candidates is April 1, 2019.**

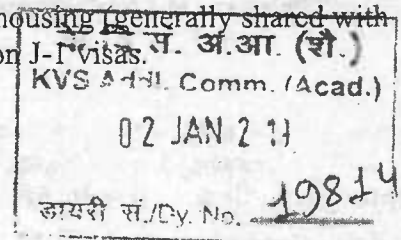
